- Identify manual processes that can be automated and develop solutions to increase automation across development workflows, security, audit systems, and compliance. Ensure that tools and processes are continually optimized to improve productivity and reduce operational overhead.
- Create, maintain, and improve the company's cloud infrastructure, including Azure Pipelines and Terraform, ensuring that it remains secure, scalable, and aligned with best practices.
- Monitor system availability and performance. Resolve alerts and incidents quickly, performing root cause analysis and ensuring continuous improvement. Proactively address potential issues before they affect operations.
- Provide support by participating in on-call duties and working flexible off-hours for planned and unplanned maintenance activities.
